Reading of Minutes: A correction to the Friars report was made. The minutes stated that 4000 children were lost to abortion per year and it should have been 4000 per day. A Motion was made to accept the minutes as published. The motion was seconded and passed.

Faithful Friar's Report: Due to Fr. Severs work schedule Hector Raymond will be filling in. Hector Talked about the importance of pre planning your funeral so that you take some of the burdens off of your family. He also talked about being doers of the word instead of just listeners. When he first came here he had decided he was going to be a "pew warmer". Monsignor Hawkins persuaded him to become involved and he got involved with Cranks Creek where he met Becky and Bobby Simpson. Becky was a "backwards country girl" who went to Washington to fight for funds for the people who had been devastated by flooding in the area. They were examples of what being doers of the word are. Because of our Cranks Creek outreach two of our young men have answered their call to the priesthood. It also encouraged Hector to follow his call to the deaconate. We need to encourage others to be doers as well by our own actions. Hector also offered his thanks for the Liturgy appreciation dinner.

Faithful Navigator Report:

Navigators Ball. This is being held again at the Confluence Park Restaurant. Cost is \$40 per couple. Cut off is February 24th, 2006.

The Exemplification. We should be actively recruiting in our Councils for new members. We need to grow! While we may think that May is an eternity away it's not, the next four months will fly. We have to recruit the members, sell ads and physically get ready for the Exemplification.

Again the Faithful Navigator took the program book so that it would grow. The 2004 book made us \$5,000. If you haven't started selling ad, now is the time! Remember one \$50 ad from each of you is all we need to cover our cost for the Exemplification. We all have places we go; we should be soliciting for the book.

The Faithful Navigator is still working on forming the Degree team, we know that some of you are already doing 1st degree duties and some even 2nd/3rd degree, but this team will save us money in the long run. Just to let you know we spend over \$1500 in renting a team to put the degree on (this is just the banquet and room charges!)

District meeting on March 5th, 1:30 pm here at Seton. The Faithful Navigator would like the officers to attend (if possible). I would also like some help in setting the room up at 1:00. Dress is Tux and Social. Any fourth degree member may also attend.

Seton Parish is having its Faith Mission March 12th thru 15th. All extra-curricular activities have been postponed so we will be meeting at St Pius at 7:30, on the 15th with an Officer meeting at 6:30 pm.

With the last newsletter we put out the procedures for waiving of dues, if anyone knows of a Brother Knight that is having problems and cannot pay their dues this year, submit a request to the Faithful Comptroller and we will work on getting it resolved. We can not help if we do not know about it.

The Faithful Navigator, the Trustees, Faithful comptroller and Purser are working on the budget for next year.

March will also bring the starting of the election process for the upcoming fraternal year. The Trustees will start working on a ballot that can be published in the April Newsletter, elections will be held at the May meeting.

Unfinished Business:

Exemplification Degree Team: - We are still 4-6 people short of filling all of the roles. The Faithful Navigator has sent a hand written letter to each of the other councils requesting volunteers for these parts.

Motion: - A Motion was made to change the business meeting time in the By-Laws from 8:00 pm on the Third Wednesday of each month to 7:30 pm on the Third Wednesday of each Month and the Social meeting from 7:00 pm on the third Wednesday of each month to 6:30 pm on the third Wednesday of each month. There was no discussion on the motion. The vote was called and the motion was passed.

Memorial: - Fran has gathered more information on the Memorial. It is 19 by 24 bronze plaques that can be mounted at a 45 degree angle either attached to the flag pole or on a rod going into the ground. The cost with the mounting kit and one name bar (Larry Lotz) is about \$650.00. Fr. Klima has agreed to allow us to place this by the flag pole. Also Council 11187 has made a donation to

the fund. We have also talked to the council to St Pius to see if they would be willing to donate. The memorial fund balance that we can use to purchase the plaque is \$18.76 and council 11187 has committed \$300.00. The rest, \$332.00 would have to come from additional donations or the general fund. There are 3 versions of name plates available that we will have to choose from as well.

We are currently allowing \$50.00 donation to be made for the Memorial and the directives will be changed so that they have a space for this. The money given in this way will go to cover the cost of the name plate. Currently 4 people have already paid this at assembly 809 and it has been transferred to our assembly.
