<u>Faithful Comptroller's Report</u>: I have not yet been able to file the newly required tax form 990N. I spoke with the IRS and

Supreme and discovered that our Tax ID was never registered with the IRS as a subordinate to KofC Supreme. That is required so that we may get 'exempt' status. *Not to worry, however*. This has now been done but it takes about three weeks to get the IRS files up-to-date with this new info. At that time (at the end of July, or so) I will be able to go online and file. I was assured by the IRS and Supreme (legal) that there will be no negative consequences because of this. I will report when this first filing is complete.

The annual audit is due by August 1. The required documents have been presented to the Faithful Navigator and Trustees for their review and action. (Brother Jerry Lowery is coordinating). As soon as Trustees have completed/signed off on the audit, I will make distribution to the proper recipients.
