At the September 26th Third District meeting Master Charles Giametta reminded to stick to basics. As Fourth Degree Knights we are the most visual representatives of the Knights of Columbus. If we are to be successful we need to be visibly active and participate in Fourth Degree events, let others know who we are and have us recognized by our good works. Let us be proud of our regalia make sure we care and display it properly, and most of all, wear it proudly. We also must make the effort and take the time to become more knowledgeable about our ceremonials. Besides the multiple available manuals, the State website (kofcohio.org/master District 3 tab) provides a vast amount of quickly available useful information.

Some pertinent information from the Provincial meeting was also stressed at our District meeting. This included our need to continually recruit 1st Degree Knights then usher and finally have them join the ranks of the Fourth Degree.

Supreme has finally made a formal ruling on the "born and not born" phrase at the end of the *Pledge of Allegiance*. By a vote of the delegates it was decided that the phrase should not be used. Therefore, this phrase should not be added whenever the pledge is recited at Knights of Columbus events.

There is also a change coming to the 4th Degree lapel pin. Promised to be enacted in November (maybe by January) the pin will be officially changed to include a design that displays both the 4th degree emblem and the flag. Once the pins become available the old pin will no longer be part of the uniform.

In attempt to give access to members regalia who do not yet own their own we are searching for members who have regalia items that are not being used or due to circumstances believe they will no longer need. If you have such items or know of someone who might be interested in helping, please contact any of the officers.
