From the `Days of Devotion by Pope John XXIII`

### “True Wisdom”

The wise man knows how to see, to look and study, in order that what he has to do may be done to perfection, with all that this implies. So he must not follow sudden irrational whims, or abandon himself to the impulses of his own nature, the nature we all like to carry around with us and treat with such clinging affection. It is instead absolutely necessary that everything be done with great discretion and prudence. We often hear the following judgment: He is a good fellow, he has a lot in him, but he’s rather strange, rather moody, up one day and down the next. No, no that will not do. It is essential to keep a sense of proportion, and to be serene with ourselves and with those around us. This is profound wisdom.

Now where are we to find this precious wisdom? We find it in abundance in the Lord’s teaching, in his blessed gospel, in principle expounded in the Old Testament, and above all in the less numerous but more impressive principle of the New Testament

Here we shall always find the way to acquire true wisdom. In this way, every time we have to make a decision, we feel naturally impelled to base it on the Lord’s teaching, and we shall act righteously because in the very name of Christ his law and the true reverence we feel in his presence, are the beginning of True Wisdom.
