The Hennepin Province Ohio District 3 Spring Exemplification is fast approaching. To assist in supporting the Exemplification I encourage each of you to sell at least 1 ad for the booklet. A copy of the ad form is enclosed for your convenience.

Exemplification events again this year will be held at the Cherry Valley Lodge in Newark, Ohio on March 25th and 26th. For those desiring to stay either one or two nights, reservations can be made by calling 740-788-1200. Requesting rooms blocked-off for the Knights of Columbus will guarantee you a room rate of \$99 per night. The Lodge is also making discount Water Park passes available for \$15 per person.

The annual Father McGivney Past Faithful Navigator Dinner Dance will be held Friday eve before the Exemplification. This event is open to all brother Knights regardless of degree, as well as those Catholic gentlemen who may be interested in learning more about the Fourth Degree. A cash bar will be open in the lobby from 6:30 to 7:30 pm and then move into the banquet hall for the remainder of the evening. The sit-down dinner will be served promptly at 7:30 pm followed by dancing from 8:30 until 11:00 pm. Men's dress for the event will be suit or sport coat and tie while ladies will be in their Sunday best. The cost for the dinner dance is \$60 per couple. Remember, our Assembly is encouraging participation and will subsidize half the cost making this a most affordable evening (\$30). In order to qualify for the discount, reservations should be made by the February Assembly meeting.

Saturday events will begin for candidates at 11:00 am with the Vesting Ceremony. The Exemplification ceremony will begin at 1:00 pm followed by Mass at 4:00 pm. A social hour with a cash bar will begin at 5:15 pm. The weekend events will conclude with the Master's Banquet at 6:30 pm. Hospitality Rooms will also be open both days after the events. The Ladies' program will begin with a luncheon at 11:30 am. Make an effort to attend and participate. It will be a memorable event and you will not be disappointed.

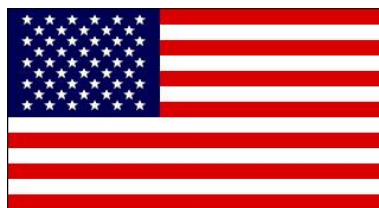
