Schools out for Summer!!!

Dear Brother SKs and Ladies:

This will be my last report for the Newsletter as Faithful Navigator. As such, forgive me once more for 'harping' on one of my concerns about what I believe could be addressed by some of my brother Knights of Columbus. . By now you probably realize I'm going to write about our opportunities to personally honor our War Veterans by attending the Honor Flights that occur during the mid-months each year. I'll start with a little background on this topic.

Memorial Day, which will have passed by the time you read this, is a day when we pause to give thanks to the people who fought for many of the things we have. There is an e-mail (creator unknown), currently on the internet, that sums up our Veterans services and contributions and I'd like to mention some of the points made in it.

- (1) "The official colors of the Memorial Day, RED, WHITE, BLUE."
- (2) "It was the Veterans efforts that gave us "Freedoms of Religion, of Speech, of the Press, and Freedoms to Assemble, to Vote, and to a Fair Trial."
- (3) "The Veterans are the real 'American Idols' and some of them "gave up all of their tomorrows so we could have ours."
- (4) "It is the Veterans that salute the American flag in parades" and other encounters and "who serves under the flag" (in his or her coffins). The e-mail ends with prayers "O Lord, grant them eternal rest and let perpetual light shine on them" and "God, Bless them all".

I thought this e-mail very effectively summarized the rationale and reasons why it would be appropriate for Knights of Columbus to attend the Honor Flights to "thank them for their service" and to "welcome the Veterans back home." I believe this effort would be a definite activity of our Columbian Degree of "Patriotism" and has been noted as such occasionally in the Knights of Columbus Columbia magazine.

To wrap up this report, the next Honor Flight is June 15th (as I'm writing), followed by a 2-month break, with Honor Flights then on September 7th and 28th and October 19th. Hope to see at least some of you there!! Full regalia is appropriate and is allowed by the airport but any KofC attire is appreciated. Veterans typically arrive back around 9:00 to 9:30 pm. Park in Short-Time area (4th level) for discounted fee and go to Southwest baggage area. Knights with Regalia or Social attire typically gather on the second floor (up stairs at back of baggage area).

Assembly 2900 Manual of the Month Knights of Columbus United States Flag Manual

Welcome to June my fellow Sir Knights.

While placing a supply order to Supreme this last month I really took notice of all of the manuals and pamphlets available to us as 4th degree Knight to help educate ourselves and others about Patriotism and our 4th degree. Many of these manuals we have in our supply here, others are available upon request from Supreme, and all have some very useful information about our degree, our Country and our Faith. Unfortunately if no one knows we have them available no one can use them, so I decided to highlight one manual or pamphlet a month. If they sound interesting to you let me know we will get you a copy. That is what we have them for.

To start us off this month's Manual is the Knights of Columbus United States Flag Manual. The manual includes a short history of the U. S. Flag, and how to display it in a wide variety of way. It describes how to properly display it at half-mast and when that is appropriate, and provides instructions on how to lower and fold the flag as well as the repair, replacement and disposition of National flags.

The final 2/3 of the manual reprints the United States Code on Flags, including Veterans Burial Benefits, the Pledge of Allegiance, Desecration of the Flag, detailed information on the displaying of the Flag at Half-Staff included for which offices and for how long, and the designation of National Flag Day and National Flag Week.

This manual is a great place to learn the basic history and evolution of the United States flag and how to display it with honor and respect. If you would like a copy please see me after our next meeting or drop me an e-mail at boilers4us@att.net
